

Calf Club Project-2017



DESIGN & BUILD A MILK BOTTLE CREATION

All children, Y4 upwards (Y3 & below optional), who do not have a calf, lamb, goat, chicken or garden must enter the project section.

Plastic milk bottles can be found in most kitchens. These bottles are made from a special plastic called **High-density polyethylene (HDPE)**. While these bottles can be recycled they can also be used to make some amazing creations!

TASK

YEAR 1 – 3 (optional)

DESIGN AND MAKE A MILK BOTTLE CREATURE

YEAR 4 – 8

DESIGN A MILK BOTTLE OBJECT THAT CAN BE USED FOR A PRACTICAL PURPOSE.

ALL PROJECTS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA;

1. Have a maximum size of 50cm long, 50cm wide and 50cm high.
2. The creature (Yr 0-3) or object (Yr 4-8) can be made from as many milk bottles as you want. However it must be within the maximum sizes listed above.
3. Judges should be able to recognise the purpose of the object that has been made with milk bottles. For years 0-3, judges should be able to recognise that it is a creature
4. The majority of the creation should be made from milk bottles. Paint, glue and staples etc can be used as well as other materials to enhance features. Please keep other material to less than 10%.
5. **Originality** and **creativity** will come into count when project is judged. A **high standard** of presentation/construction is expected.
6. Children undertaking the project must supply an A3 sheet with drawings showing initial ideas, development of your chosen idea and a final plan with important features. The plan needs to include four photos, taken both at the start during construction to prove that they have been made by the student.
7. All creations need to be able to stand on their own while being displayed at school.

You could decorate your creation by:

- Painting it.
- Cutting the bottles into shapes or using parts of the bottles to create shapes.
- Gluing items onto it.
- Weaving, plating, and melting the milk bottles.
